The Southeastern Institute has established an Education Scholarship of **up to \$5,000** to be awarded annually to an agency who has demonstrated strong support of IIANC and of its Education programs. The Institute presented its first scholarship at the 2008 IIANC Annual Convention.

The Education Committee of IIANC has developed a set of criteria for the award and an application form which can be used to submit nominations. The following are the major qualification guidelines:

- Active involvement with IIANC by serving on committees and/or attending conventions and conferences
- Support of IIANC Education as evidenced by attendance at IIANC courses
- Contributions to NCPAC and INSURPAC
- Trusted Choice® Agent

A point system will be used to rate each application. A sliding scale will be used to evaluate the percentages of staff to Event/CE ratio, allowing us to compare large and small agencies more fairly. Applications will be blinded (all identifying information removed) before being evaluated by the Committee.

The scholarship provides for **reimbursement** of education expenses including tuition, travel, and travel-related expenses up to a total of \$5,000 for the 12-month period following receipt of the scholarship. The money does NOT have to be used exclusively for IIANC-sponsored education.
